FIELD NAMES and LOCATIONS

Code	Field	Location
BHS:	Berkeley High School	Milvia & Channing, enter at Milvia near Durant
COD:	Codornices	Euclid at Eunice, upper level across from Rose Garden
FF:	Fielding Field	5th St. North of Harrison, enter where 5th dead ends
GIL:	Gilman	Bottom of Gilman, in the Tom Bates Regional Sports Complex, next to frontage road
GRO:	Grove-Russell	Martin Luther King Jr. at Russell, enter along Russell St.
JK:	James Kenney	7th and Delaware, enter at corner
KMS:	King Middle School	Rose at Edith, enter at gate where Edith St. dead ends
LL:	La Loma	La Loma at El Portal, enter at dead end of El Portal.(Up Cedar to top, left on La Loma and follow the curves. El Portal will be on your left)
LMS:	Longfellow Middle School	Derby at Sacramento, enter pedestrian gate on Derby
OHL:	Ohlone Field	Sacramento & Delaware, across from No. Berk. BART
OV:	Ocean View	Buchanan (Marin) at Taylor, enter going East on Buchanan
RP:	Rosa Parks School	Allston Way between 8 th and 9 th St, enter along Allston
SP:	San Pablo Park	Oregon between San Pablo and Sacramento, the field we use is called "San Pablo 2" and is nearest the tennis courts.

Berkeley Unified School District Fields:

Berkeley High, King Middle, Longfellow Middle, and Rosa Parks.

City Of Berkeley Fields:

Codornices, Grove, James Kenny, La Loma, San Pablo Park and Ohlone.

City of Albany Fields:

Ocean View

Field Sharing Abbreviations: Fields may appear on team schedules suffixed by a "1" or a "2". This means that 2 teams are sharing the field; the team whose schedule has a "1" starts in the infield and the team with a "2" starts in the outfield. Half-way through the teams switch. Coaches are free to work out other arrangements when fields are shared (e.g., a joint practice).
